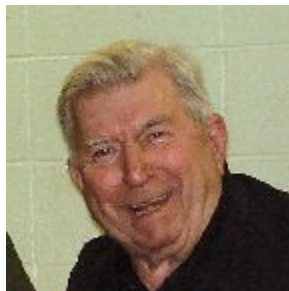
2009 CHRISTMAS PARTY
